Application documents

Depending on the admission requirements of the respective curriculum, the following documents must be submitted for individual review for admission to a continuing education (study) program at the University for Continuing Education Krems:

Appendix Continuing Education Tuition Fee

CV in Europass format

Letter of Intent

📎 Template with instructions

Identification document (valid passport or identity card)

Proof of general university entrance qualification (i.e. a school-leaving certificate – usually a secondary-school certificate – which qualifies you for university study)

Proof of higher education degree (award certificate and diploma supplement or transcript of records) and, if applicable, corresponding certifications and/or translations of international documents in accordance with the applicable certification regulations

Proof of professional qualification or completed training (e.g. training or qualification certificates from vocational secondary schools, apprenticeships)

Proof of fulfillment of specific admission requirements according to the curriculum

Proof of training and further education relevant to admission (e.g. certificates, confirmations of participation)

Certificate of name change (e.g. marriage certificate, notification of name change), if applicable.

Notes

The documents listed are not necessarily required for each continuing education (study) program. The mandatory documents depend on the admission requirements of the chosen curriculum.

As part of the application process in the online application tool, the system will generate a „Registration and Application for Admission“ document based on your information, which you will need to print and sign or electronically sign.

The Study Program Director may request additional documentation as part of the selection process, such as employer references, language proficiency documentation, etc.

Different regulations take effect when applying for a Micro-Credential Program (MCP) or PhD studies. These can be found on the website of the chosen (study) program or in the curriculum.
