# The public University Library Krems is available to students and staff on campus (UWK, IMC, KL) as well as alumni and external users..

## Facilities

Reading places are barrier-free on the ground floor of the open-access library and in the learning room (1st floor) including Wi-Fi. In the library, you will find a copier, a book scanner, and public PC workstations. In the foyer, we offer group workspaces, an open bookshelf for exchanging entertainment literature, and lockers for storage during the library visit. The return box is used for returning books outside of opening hours..

## Literature collection

The collection focuses on the study and teaching programs on the Krems campus. Additionally, eBooks and numerous digital journals are available in full-text access. As a special feature, the collections of the Kunstmeile Krems are preserved and made accessible to the public.

## Usage

The physical collection of the university library can be searched using the library catalog. You can find access to this on our homepage. Professional journals and daily newspapers are available in the reading room and can be used during opening hours.

Electronic resources (e-journals, e-books, and licensed professional databases) can be searched via our research tool "BIBER" and the library catalog (PRIMO Flex). For UWK students, remote access is also possible..

## Registration

Students of the University for Continuing Education Krems receive access to their library account after redeeming the PIN in the UWKonline portal. Library accounts for students of IMC Krems and the Karl Landsteiner Private University are generated once at the beginning of their studies. Students are informed by email about the creation of the account and can set their password themselves. External users can register at the university library with a valid photo ID.



## Borrowing

Max. 10 media units for a period of 4 weeks.

An independent extension of the borrowing period via the online account is possible, provided the books are not reserved by another user.

## Return

At the counter during opening hours or in the book return cart in the foyer. Postal return is also possible..

## Resource ordering

The university library of UWK offers you the possibility to order literature (both books and articles from journals) from domestic and foreign libraries to Krems (pickup ONLY on-site). Further information about this paid service can be found on our homepage.

## Door

Door offers all UWK members the opportunity to publish digital materials. The freely accessible platform includes secondary publications from scientific publishers as well as the university press - UWK Press, OER (Open Educational Resources), research data, project reports, publisher publications, and much more.
