





Information for participants on organizing an event as a Green Meeting/Green Event

Dear participants!

We would like to certify our event according to the guidelines of the Ecolabel for Green Meetings and Green Events. To this end, we are taking many visible and invisible measures, such. We would be delighted if you would also support these efforts from your side.

For your journey to Krems

- We try to make it as easy as possible for you to travel by public transport. If possible, please opt for an environmentally friendly journey or form car pools.
- We recommend using public transportation whenever possible! There are train connections to Krems from Vienna, St. Pölten and Horn with ÖBB trains. You can find more information online. Information on the regional bus connections of the VOR can also be online.
- Participants who wish to form carpools can plan a joint arrival and departure online via the Greendrive platform if they are not traveling by public transport. Please use the app: Greendrive - carpooling & carpooling for commuters.
- If you cannot do without a car, we would be pleased if you offset the resulting CO2 emissions through compensation payments (see, for example, the CO2 compensation system of the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Vienna).

Transfer in Krems to the University for Continuing Education Krems

- The campus can be reached by bus with the city bus line 1 (barrier-free low-floor bus) and the campus shuttle bus 717. The city bus runs every 30 minutes on weekdays between 04:50 and 18:50 from Krems/Danube train station or 04:01 and 19:01 from the Danube University stop. The journey takes around 10 minutes.
- The university can also be easily reached by bike from Krems train station in around 10 minutes. Nextbike bike rental stations can be found both at the train station and on campus. If you are traveling with your own bike, there are numerous bicycle parking spaces on campus.
- It takes 20 to 25 minutes to walk between Krems/Danube train station and the University for Continuing Education Krems.







Waste avoidance

- Reusable is environmental protection: Prefer open drinks, food on crockery, milk and sugar without portion packaging, etc.
- Dispose of your waste (PET, glass, paper, etc.) via the separate collection offered at the event.
- If possible, use online registrations or digital materials instead of paper printouts/handouts.
- Use your own writing utensils.
- Please return your badges/name badges to the information desk at the end of the event.
- Use your own drinking bottles for refilling. Tap water is provided free of charge.
