

## The experience of the Dual System in the VET Education in Veneto (Italy)

The dual system in Italy represents the meeting point between the world of work, which requires increasingly more technical and trained skills, and the vocational training system, which is committed to equipping young people with practical skills that can be used in a constantly and rapidly evolving work context, promoting the growth of professionalism and reducing the skill mismatch with the training world.
