

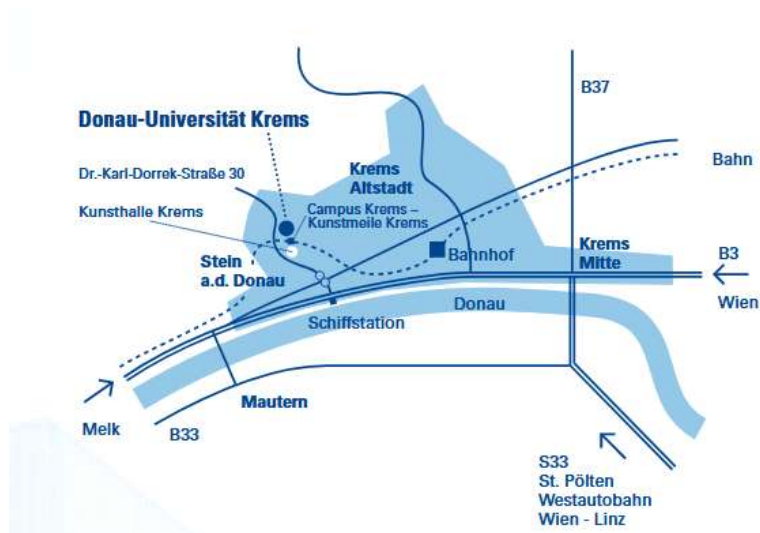

Library Stock

The book stock is studies- and teaching-program-oriented at Campus Krems. The library stock is continuously expanded and offers a wide array of print media and electronic resources covering current research fields and other interests.

How can I use the library?

You can search the university library using the online catalogue which you can easily access through our website.

Special interest literature is mainly available in the reading hall in the area where the publications are orderly laid out for free.

Special interest journals and daily newspapers are at hand in the reading hall, available during opening hours.

By using the search tool "biber", you can search the electronic- and full text data base system.

Due to the current situation, it is not possible to use our reading room. Books can be borrowed after consultation and picked up at the counter.

How can I register as library user?

Students from Danube University Krems, IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems, and from the Karl Landsteiner Private University are automatically registered as users of the university library.

External readers are invited to register at the university library by showing a valid photo ID.



How can I borrow an item?

Members of the universities at the Campus can borrow 10 media items for four weeks; external users are permitted 5 media items for two weeks.

You can extend the duration of the loan period independently as long as the books have not been booked in advance by another user.

Borrowed items can be returned at the information counter. Outside the opening hours you can place them in the book return cart.

Further Services

Inter Library Loan and Document Delivery

Literature and journal articles can be ordered from universities in Austria and abroad, subsequently you can directly pick them up at our university library. The costs for this service you will find online on our website.

Library instruction courses

Trainings on the electronic search in catalogues, data bases and e-journals as well as on the use of individual library accounts are scheduled with the library staff.

Working spaces

The library of the university provides all users approximately a hundred working spaces with wi-fi access and 30 PC-equipped research stations. The learning spaces on the first floor are separated from the service area and open Monday to Sunday from 7am until 10pm.
